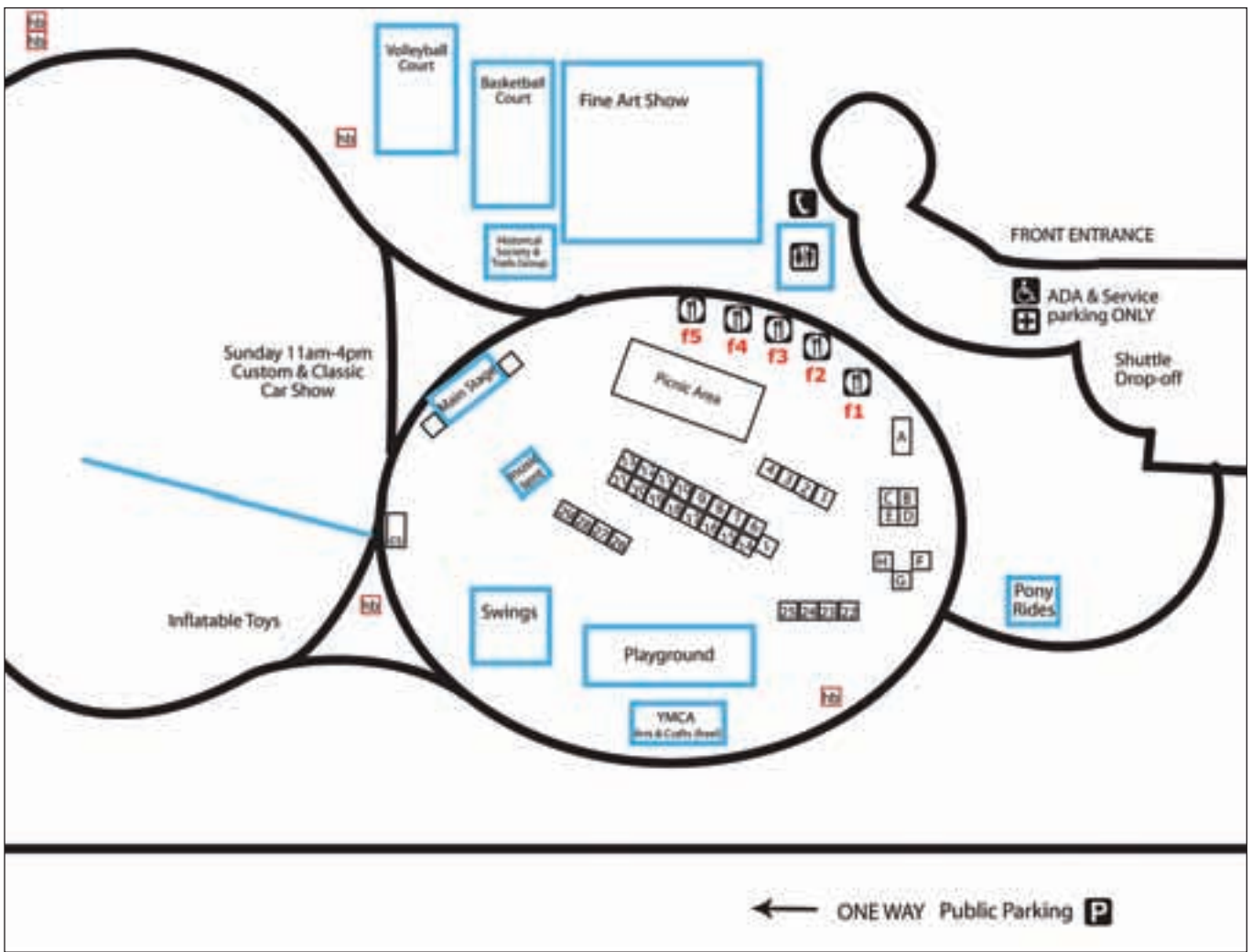

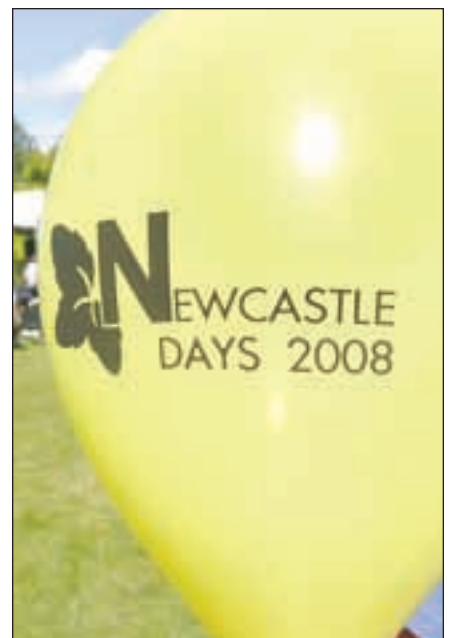
Lake Boren Park's main parking lot will be reserved for disabled drivers and service vehicles during Newcastle Days.

Local businesses provide tax dollars for city roads, parks and services. Of every \$100 spent at a local store, \$47 stays in the community.

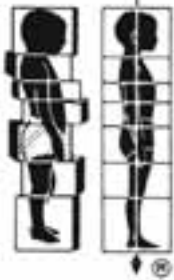
Local businesses also create
